STORY

The TEQ table was designed to offer many possibilities for sport lovers of all ages and backgrounds. The TEQ ONE is the first professional-level version of the TEQ table, released in 2014. If you are a professional athlete or if you are just looking for a fun activity to improve your coordination, ball skills and cognitive abilities, you'll be able to find your teqsport. Teqball is the oldest and most-popular sport in the group that also includes teqvoly, teqpong, teqis, and qatch. Teqball is the fastest growing sport in the world. It already has more than 130 National Federations worldwide with the goal to be included as a medal sport at the 2028 Los Angeles Summer Olympics.



FITEQ

Established in March 2017, the Fédération Internationale de Teqball (FITEQ) is the governing body presiding over all matters relating to the sport of teqball. In 2021 FITEQ has more than 110 National Federations worldwide. The sport of teqball has enjoyed strong growth over the last few years as a result of increasing athlete participation, a growing competition calendar, an expanding fanbase and the ongoing development of strategic partnerships. As far as the event calendar is concerned, four successful editions of the Teqball World Championships have been held. The 4th World Championships was held in Gliwice, Poland where 42 countries participated in front of a capacity audience of 10000 spectators, including distinguished personalities such as IOC Members, NOC Executive Directors, and high profile sports stars from across the world.

RECOGNITION AND PARTNERS

Teqball has been officially recognised by the Olympic Council of Asia (OCA), the Association of National Olympic Committees of Africa (ANOCA) and the Organisation of Sports Federations of Oceania (OSFO). FITEQ was granted full membership of the Global Association of International Sports Federations (GAISF) on 10 November 2020, which resulted in automatic membership of the Alliance of Independent Recognised Members of Sport (AIMS). FITEQ is a Signatory to the World Anti-Doping Code and also collaborates with multiple partners, including the International Testing Agency (ITA), The Association For International Sport for All (TAFISA), the International School Sport Federation (ISF), Peace and Sport and the Olympic Channel. In 2021, teqball has been added to the European Games 2023 programme as a medal sport, which is Europe's most prestigious multi-sport event.

TEQBALL

Teqball is the purest form of football, played on a specially curved table with no physical contact between the players. It's a truly gender inclusive game, attracting a new generation of athletes or amateur enthusiasts whose ambition is to develop their technical skills, concentration and stamina. This football-based sport has already conquered the world as it is played in more than 130 countries of the world including football superstars like, Lionel Messi, Ronaldinho, Neymar and clubs like Manchester United, FC Barcelona and Paris SG. If one likes football, they will love teqball!



TEQVOLY

Teqvoly is a perfect leisure activity for every sport enthusiasts, and also, it can be an excellent complementary exercise for professional volleyball players. The rules have been designed to make the rallies more exciting and enjoyable both for the players and the spectators as well. It improves ball concentration, reaction time and precision. Our main goal with this innovative sport is to create global awareness, promote the sport for professional and amateur players alike and implement teqvoly into the everyday practice of volleyball players.



QATCH

Qatch is originated from handball and is perfectly suitable for professional athletes as well as amateur enthusiasts whose ambition is to develop both their attacking and defending skills. In this physically challenging game, two teams of three players throw the ball back and forth to each other in an intense manner. What makes this new and innovative sporting activity stand out, is that two players from the same team (the attackers) are at the same end of the table, while the third player (the defender) is at the opposite end among their opponents. Teamwork, feelings and experiences, freedom of creativity and quick decisions.



TEQSPORTS

TEQPONG

Teqpong is an other form of an innovative racket sport. The curved teq table makes the game even more enjoyable creating various types of bounces whereby angles need to be recalculated and your reactions will be tested. Teqpong is an excellent way to spend time for both professional athletes and those who are looking for a recreational hobby, regardless of age, gender, or level of skills.

TEQIS

Teqis is an innovative racket sport. Besides its enjoyable and fun elements, it develops and demands competencies from the players such as focus, quick reaction, and technical precision, since the ball bounces differently because of the curved shape of the Teq table. Teqis can be played indoors and outdoors as well on many different surfaces, like clay, hard court, grass, carpet, or sand, which make teqis even more enjoyable and give the players more challenges.

PARA TEQSPORTS

Para teqball and para teqsports are para sports activities that can be played on the multifunctional sports equipment, the Teq table, which is a 100% Hungarian innovation. They have been developed for people with disabilities: para teqball and para teqvoly are for athletes with limb deficiencies, while para teqis and para teqpong can be played by wheelchair-user athletes. All of them can be played and enjoyed by players at all levels, regardless of age or gender. The inclusive categories make para teqball and para teqsports even more unique in the world of para sports, as non-disabled and disabled people can play together without any discrimination or disadvantage. Our goal is to embrace and spread all the values para sports represent: determination, courage, inspiration, equality.
